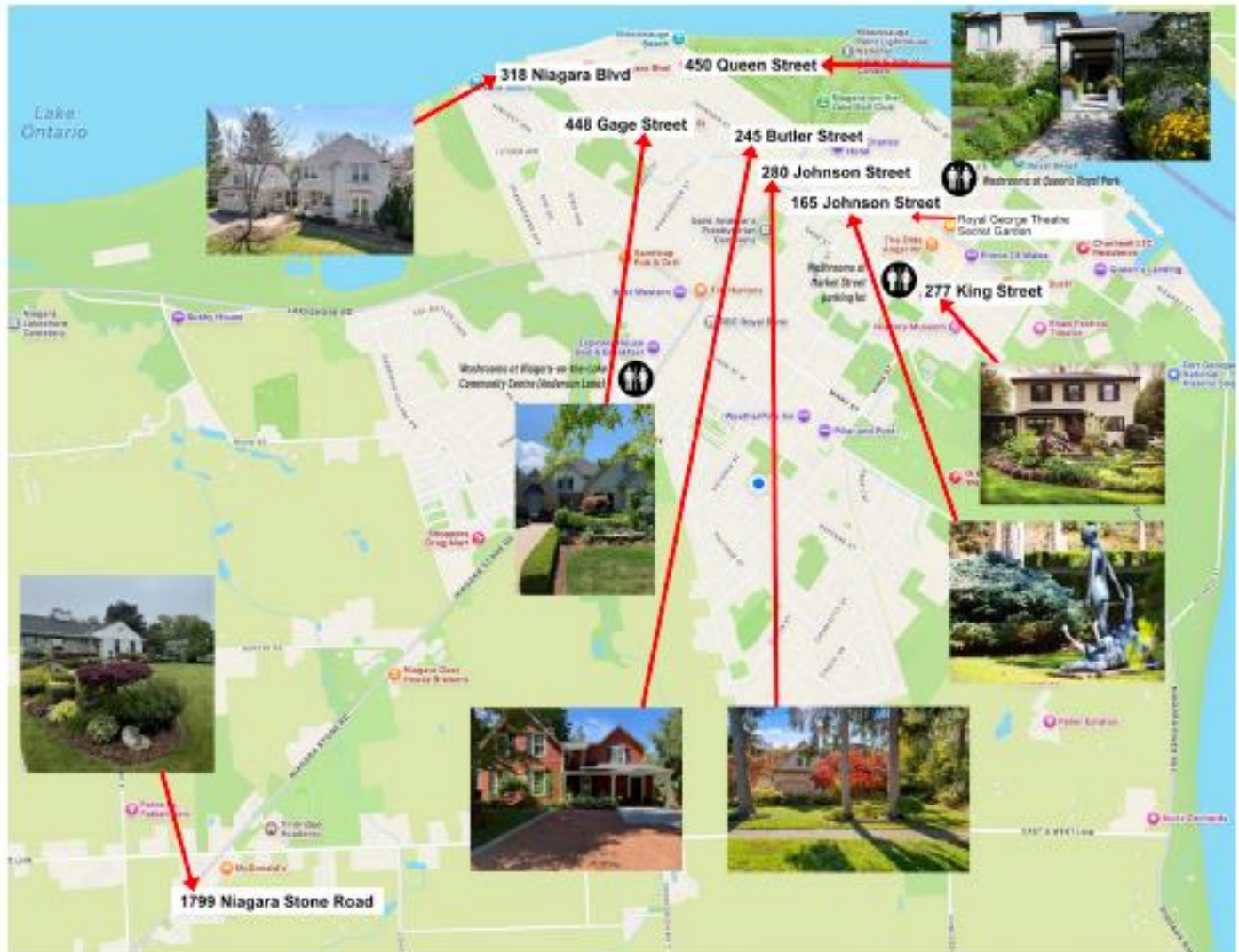

Classically designed gardens of Boxwood, Hydrangeas, Roses, Lavender and other garden favourites, edged with retaining walls, accent the different levels. As you arrive, you will hear the gentle sounds of water trickling from a fountain surrounded by roses, hydrangea, magnolia, dogwood trees, Japanese maples, and mixes of annuals.

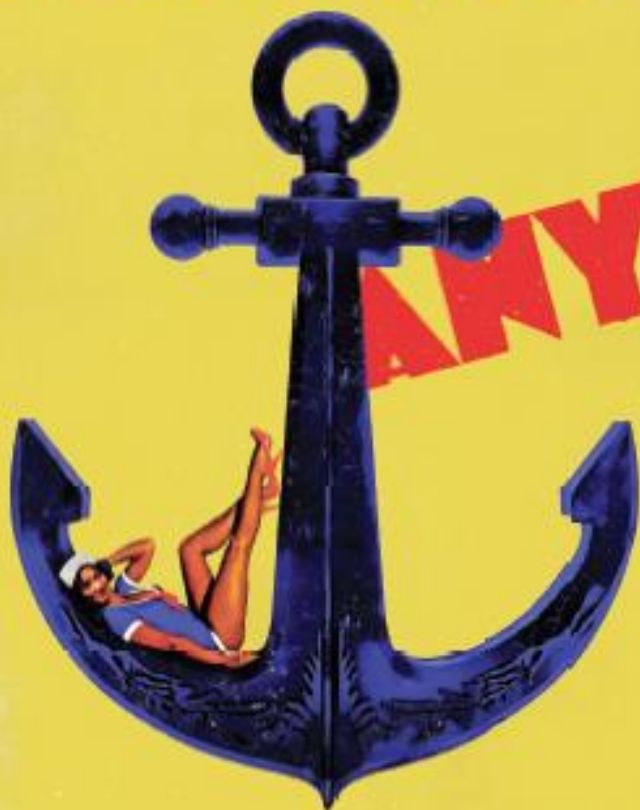
The homeowners have maintained and added many varieties of shrubs, trees, and flowers over the years that bloom in different seasons creating a vibrant and dynamic garden with year-round interest.

The backyard private garden welcomes you via a path through a row of dogwood trees, past a sitting area and pool that lead you to a microclimate of over 20 varieties of Japanese maples and rhododendrons. Within, winding paths take you to different garden areas highlighting specimen plants. The waterfall attracts wildlife and birds and adds to the overall enjoyment of this oasis of tranquility.

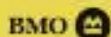

Shaw's on the Lake

450 Queen Street



This property boasts plenty of solid design principles and plant combinations that are easily adaptable regardless of your budget, climate or space limitations. On this 180' x 78' lot, the architecture of the home is the backbone of the garden design.

The garden joins the sleek modern interior to the exterior space. The technique used was layering - grouping plants that creates different effects from various sightlines with a restricted colour palette of reds, purple and whites. Dense plantings and vigorous varieties keep the borders lush.

This structural approach to the design and plant partnering creates clean lines and a modern aesthetic in this garden.

Neatly tucked within Old Town is an oasis of calm, and a garden to delight the senses. This unique, contemporary and visionary space is one-of-a-kind. The Garden is a series of interconnected spaces that do not reveal themselves at first glance; you must go out and explore the grounds to see each garden room with layers of colour and intricate textures. Several spots in the garden can only be seen from unique points, making wandering about the property a bit of an adventure. Long vistas through the diagonal of the property create a real sense of largeness and several seats are positioned to take advantage of this aspect. The garden design developed organically from the topography and the Creekside nature of the property with music and art as guiding factors. An inspired latest addition is the sculpture garden. The creation of this garden was a collaborative effort, developed slowly over the years, and the result is a lovely secluded, quiet garden in the midst of the often busy Old Town.

This perennial garden has matured and developed into a beautiful array of colours over the past 18 years that the current owners have lived here. The front yard has a free form lawn that entices you to look more carefully at the many different flowers and shrubs. While the Japanese Maple standing in front of the house pulls your view into the architecture of the modern two story home, the Dogwood tree when in full bloom shows beautifully at the entrance to the driveway.

The entrance to the back yard runs along the left side of the house. A raised garden of vegetables and herbs can be seen as you walk through the gates to the large very private backyard. You will feel like you are in a private resort as you walk around the garden and the pool.

This renovated century home sits well back from the front sidewalk on a 1/3 acre lot, while the rear yard provides a refuge from the busy street and sidewalk traffic.

Since acquiring the property in 2007 – and with the exception of the mature Spruce, Oak and Walnut trees – the current owners completely replanted the gardens with perennials, shrubs and ornamental trees.

The “basso profundo” wind chime provides a unique focal point in a backyard oasis.

1799 Niagara Stone Road



In the 1960's this home and garden was the CIL Lawn & Garden Model Home and Information Centre. Over the years it was transformed by the previous owners and greatly enriched by the current owners.

At the entrance of the driveway, you are greeted by a purple beech, approximately 30 feet high and to your left and right several flower beds with contrasting evergreen shrubs for colour and texture as well as Peonies, Dogwood and Rose of Sharon. The owners added a new perennial garden to the front in 2021. The path to the left under a canopy of trees leads you to a beautiful hydrangea garden and further on to a sitting area under a 60' chestnut tree. Meander further to find, various garden vignettes, including a "she shed" (The Queen's Quarters), gazebo, fire pit, as well as a water feature and pool area with change room. As you exit the other side of the house you will be surrounded by hostas, ostrich ferns, a yellow magnolia tree and another purple beech tree.

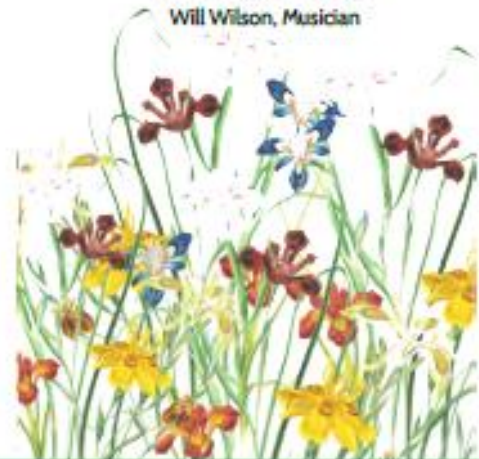

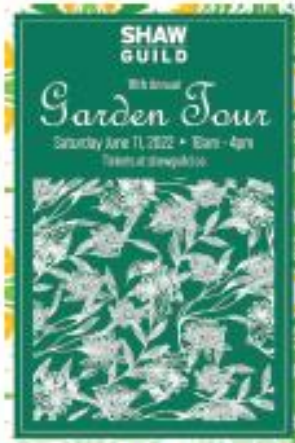
